Yesterday the government released their guidance for schools to reopen to all children from September. Whilst we are incredibly pleased that we will be able to welcome the whole school back, we understand that many of you may still be nervous about returning. I want to reassure you now that we will be working over the coming weeks to make sure school is ready for September and that all the safety measures from the guidance are in place. The success of our partial reopening over the last month for priority year groups has given us confidence about the way forward. All of the steps we have taken so far are available for parents to see on a risk assessment displayed on our school website. We will be updating this risk assessment in line with the new guidance ready for September. Many of the succesful measures in place now will almost certainly remain in some form, such as the staggered start and finish times to the day – more information will be available for parents in the near future. In the meantime, thank you for your patience and support.
